Discovered by Portuguese Sailors in 1544 they named Taiwan Ilha Formosa, "The Beautiful Island".

Taiwan is often overlooked but has so much to offer from this small island rich both in natural beauty and culture. With some of the best fusion cuisine around, top road cycling, excellent mountain trekking, the mist-shrouded forests, soaring peaks, plunging coastal cliffs, world-class tea &coffee, the best bubble tea to boast, Taiwan is the perfect holiday destination for you and your family.

First of all the weather and best times to go. Taiwan is a tropical Island, winter is not to cold but summers are very hot! Winter is December, January and February are Winter but it does not snow and generally temperatures average around 18 degrees but can go as low at 10 degrees, However the humidity can make it feel colder. During March, April and May it is **Spring** and September, October and November Autumn. These are a highly recommended times visit the beautiful Island of Taiwan. June, July and August are Summer and it is hot ranging between 30 and 33 degrees at its peak.

Taiwan is not a huge Island measuring at 394km long and 144 kms wide and home to 23.2 million people. Even though there are many people here you do not notices the crowds outside of the main cities. All the locals are very welcoming and eager to teach you about their history and culture.

Currency is New Taiwanese dollars. Major credit cards are accepted and it is very convenient to get money out. The easiest option is to find your local 7/11 where there will be an ATM to withdraw cash.



To use the buses and MRT (railway) the easiest option is to pick up an Easy Card either at the MRT or a convenience store. Load it with some money you will have access to Buses, MRT and you can also use it to purchases items from the 7/11's, Family Mart and other shops for your convenience.

Then take a visit to Ita **Thao Indigenous Village**, **Ci-en Pagoda** and **Xuanzhuang Temple** and visitor center.



### DAY - 2 Taipei – Taroko – Taipei (B,L)

This morning you will be meet by your private guide in the hotel lobby and be transferred to the railway station to experience the iconic **Taroko National Park**. Visit the Taroko Gorge Gateway, Shakadan Trail, Changchun Temple (also known as the Eternal spring) Swallow Caves and Tianxiang.

Experience the amazing **Taroko National Park**. Taroko became a national park in 1986, including Hualien County, Nantou County and Taichung City. Taroko is famous for its spectacular mountains and marble canyons. Cliffs and canyons stretch along **Liwu River**. Four million years ago, the island of Taiwan was formed by the collision of plates. After millions of years of wind erosion, the marble rocks were exposed and cut by Liwu River, creating impressive grand canyons. From Qingshui to Nanhu Peak, the drop height is 3,742 meters. Such special geography has also bred special flora and fauna in this area. Take a walk through **Swallow Grotto** trail which runs about a half kilometer starting from the entrance to Swallow Grotto to the Jinheng Bridge, you can enjoy the sights of the Liwu River from nearly straight above the water, the potholes on the cliff faces, the springs sprinkled along the lower parts of the walls, as well as the famous rock formation **"Chieftain's profile rock"**. Explore **Qingshui Cliff** which is a 21 kilometer length of coastal cliffs averaging 800 meters above sea level in Xiulin Township, Hualien County, Taiwan. The tallest peak, Qingshui Mountain, rises 2408 meters directly from the Pacific Ocean. The cliff is located at the southern part of the Suhua Highway that connects the counties of Yilan and Hualien in eastern Taiwan. It is considered to be a very scenic area and is the highest coastal cliff in Taiwan. Evening return to Taipei at approximately 6pm.

On your return to Taipei city your will see the beautiful **Qixing Lake** and **Hualien Stone Sculptural Park**. Evening at your leisure to explore.




### Taipei (B)

With over 100 square kilometers, the lake got its name because the northern part of it has the shape of the sun and the southern part of it has the shape of crescent moon (those two parts are separated by Lalu Island). "Autumn Moon Scene of the Sun Moon Lake" is considered as the most attractive 12 sights in Taiwan.

#### Taipei - Kaohsiung (B) DAY - 2

On your arrival in Kaohsiung we travel to Fo Guang Shan which is north-east of Dashu Township in Kaohsiung. Here you will find the Buddhist center of South Taiwan, established by Master Hsing Yun and his disciples. Next discover Pier 2 Art Center, once an abandoned and forgotten warehouse buried in history due to the move from an industrial based segment to the service sector. After we take a ferry to Qijing Island. Enjoy an authentic rickshaw ride on the island and discover Qijin Old Street lined with restaurants selling fresh and budget-friendly seafood alfresco style.

This evening explore the amazing Liuhe Night Market. No matter what you like to have, a variety of delicious food, specialties, cold drinks, ices and seafood here are offered for your choice. Just remind you, don't miss the opportunity to taste the papaya milk and steamed salty shrimps in Kaohsiung.

### DAY - 3 Kaohsiung – Kenting - Kaohsiung (B)

Today explore the natural beauty southern Taiwan has to offer starting your tour at **Maobitou** is located in the west cape of southern Taiwan. Next we go to "Taiwan's tail" also known as **Eluanbi Park**. Created in 1982 Eluanbi Park is the island's southernmost point and is home to the Eluanbi lighthouse also called "The Light of East Asia" standing 21.4 meters tall it is famous for being the brightest lighthouse in Asia.

This afternoon on our way back to Kaohsiung we stop at **Longpan**. This area is based on the tableland of coral reef limestone. Then we travel to the city of Hengchun which is the entry way to **Kenting National Park**, the southernmost National Park in the country. Hengchun is home to pristine beaches and a vibrant atmosphere for tourist. The city itself was once completely surrounded by a city wall, however now about half of the wall remains intact, as well as the four city gates.

On your arrival back in Kaohsiung you are free at your leisure.

### DAY - 4 Kaohsiung – Taipei (B)

This morning check out form your hotel and we travel to Tainan city our first stop is **Chikanlou** originally built by the Dutch in 1652. Chikanlou was originally named Provintia which in Dutch means eternity.

Continue on to **Koxinga Shrine** the only Fujianese style shrine in Taiwan. This shrine was built in memory of the work and achievements of Cheng Cheng Kung the pioneer of Taiwan. Before heading back to Taipei city we travel to **Anping Fort** also built by the Dutch in 1624 but originally called "Fort Zeelandia". This fort was used during the Dutch regime and was the hub for trading. In 1661, the fort was renamed as Anping to commemorate his home town when Guoxingye (Cheng Cheng-Kung) has driven the Dutch out of Taiwan. Also discover **the Anping Tree House** originally a British trading company Tait and Co. The aerial roots and branches of the trees wrap around the building creating an unusual sight.On your arrival back in Kaohsiung you are free at your leisure.

This afternoon take a high-speed train back to Taipei. Evening at your leisure.






